



Sus Hat by Simply Socks Yarn Co

Size: Adult Medium, approx. 20" circumference. Can be made larger or smaller by adding or decreasing in multiples of 10.

Yarn: 1 skein of Hedgehog Fibres Tweedy DK in Dreaming in Light (MC), 1 skein of Madelinetosh Tosh DK in Neon Pink (CC1), 1 skein of Madelinetosh Tosh DK in Natural (CC2). Used only partial skeins, 35g/15g/15g, respectively. A great project for leftover skeins.

Needles: US 4 (3.5mm) 16" circular needle, US 5 (3.75mm) 16" circular needle, US 5 (3.75mm) double point needles.

Gauge: 5.5 sts = 1"

Abbreviations: k = Knit. k2tog = Knit two together, p = purl

Pattern Notes: This is a super vacation project- something to get accomplished in just a day or two. I was able to get this hat finished in just two days, while hanging out with my kids who were playing Among Us and told me that the hat was "So simple it's sus," per the lingo of their game. I liked it and the Sus Hat was born! This hat really is nicely adaptable – adding stripes of various colors to use up stash, or making shorter or longer depending on how slouchy you like a hat.



Pattern

Brim: Using US 4 circ, cast on 100 stitches. Join into a round and place a marker at the beginning of the round. As always, when joining, don't twist your stitches.

k2, p2 to end of the round. Repeat this round for 13 more rounds and you'll have a nice, elastic brim.

Body:

Switch to US 5 circular needles. For the body of the hat, you'll do a simple stockinette stitch for all rows, continuing for 7", changing colors whenever you'd like. For this particular look/stripe, do the following stripe:

14 rows HF Tweedy-Dreaming in Light (MC)

7 rows MT Tosh DK in Natural (CC1)

7 rows MT Tosh DK in Neon Pink (CC2)

If you knit your brim entirely in Dreaming in Light like is shown, you'll now switch to Natural to start the Body of the hat. Then after 7 rows, you'll go to Neon Pink. Then back to Tweedy-Dreaming in Light. *If you'd like a slouchier hat, knit 8 or 9 inches instead of the 7" shown here.*

Decrease for crown:

Once your hat is as long as you'd like, 7" shown here, simply decrease as follows:

Row 1: *k3, k2tog*, repeat to end of round

Rows 2-4: k all sts

Row 5: *k2, k2tog*, repeat to end of round

Rows 6-7: k all sts (smaller circumference requires switching to your DPNs)

Row 8: *k1, k2tog*, repeat to end of round

Row 9: k all sts

Row 10: k2tog (10 sts remain, if you cast on 100)

Row 11: k2tog

Row 12: 5 sts left. Cut yarn to approx. 10 inches. Thread yarn through live stitches and cinch closed.

Weave in ends. Enjoy being Sus!
